Walking Unaccompanied Summer Term 2018

For those parents of children in Year 5 and 6 who wish to allow their child to walk unaccompanied or be met or collected at an arranged location off site after school, this agreement asks parents to detail the arrangements for the safety of their children and to ensure arrangements are clear to all parties. Abbey School will assume that unless we hear to the contrary, pupils are dropped off and collected by a parent, carer or attend Lindees at the start/end of the day.

I give permission for my Year 5 or 6 child to walk unaccompanied or to be collected at a mutually arranged point and agree to the following conditions:

1. If my child brings a mobile phone to school, I understand that my child and I must complete, in advance, the School Mobile Phone Agreement available from the School Office.
 - a) With this in place, I will ensure that the School Office telephone number is stored on the mobile phone as a contact- 01727 851802, Option 6. In addition to the police non-emergency number 101.
 - b) As per the School Mobile Phone Agreement, phones should be turned off and out of sight before entering the school grounds.
 - c) My child is not permitted to use their mobile phone on the school site.
2. Should my child be unable to contact their parent on the way home, I understand that my child can contact the School Office until 4.30pm if they wish to seek urgent assistance or have any concerns on their journey and I confirm that they are aware of this and have been instructed how to do so. If my child does not have a mobile phone, they understand that they can return to school if necessary, until 4.30pm.
3. In the event that alternative arrangements are made between parent, carer or child, I understand that the School Office must be notified prior to this being carried out by 3pm at the latest on the day of the arrangement. Remembering that children's mobile phones are off during the School day and when on site.
4. In the event that my child makes alternative arrangements without consent, I accept that the School will not be held responsible.
5. I accept that if any of the above conditions fail to be observed on any occasion, the matter or circumstance will be recorded and dealt with in line with our School Behaviour Policy.
6. I will return the slip below to my child's teacher in advance of allowing my child to walk home unaccompanied.
7. It is the parents' responsibility to notify the School Office if this changes at any point.
8. As is protocol, parents are to notify children's absence to the School Office by 9.30am. Unauthorised absences are followed up after this time.
