Abbey School Remote Learning User Agreement 2021

1. Best endeavours for children to complete remote learning and attend live elements.
2. Children must not use a background or blur the background on Google Classroom.
3. Children must join live elements with microphone muted and should have cameras on.
4. Children must be facing forward, looking and concentrating on the teacher.
5. Pupils must be dressed appropriately - no pyjamas, hats, hoods.
6. Children must use 'Hand up' icon to request to speak.
7. The same standard of behaviour and work is expected from pupils as in school.
8. Children must use appropriate language in responses, both verbal and written: e.g. no text speak. Teachers may turn the comments off if being misused.
9. No eating during live session – including breakfast and snacks.
10. Devices need audio: feedback from teachers maybe via verbal audio using Mote.
11. It is essential that children join promptly; no joining without teacher.
12. Pupils/parents must not capture, store or share the video/audio content.
13. No ClassDojo/Google Classroom passwords to be reset - if already done please inform office.
14. No mobiles phones in hand or nearby please.
15. Parents must monitor child's behaviour, participation, contribution and work submitted online whilst working remotely.
16. When learning from home, children should be in a suitable working space, ideally not in their bedroom, but if this is the only place pupils can work, parents must ensure they know their child is about to have a live session and that the bedroom door is open.
17. Parents, you need to be aware that school cannot monitor the students use of and access to the internet while they are at home. If you have concerns these websites may be helpful: CEOP, UK Safer Internet Centre and Childline.
18. Teachers will monitor attendance at live sessions and of work submitted. Contact will be made where there is limited participation.
19. Teachers will delete Google Classroom assignments older than two weeks.
20. There may be occasions where the teacher is ill; on these occasions there will be no live elements.
